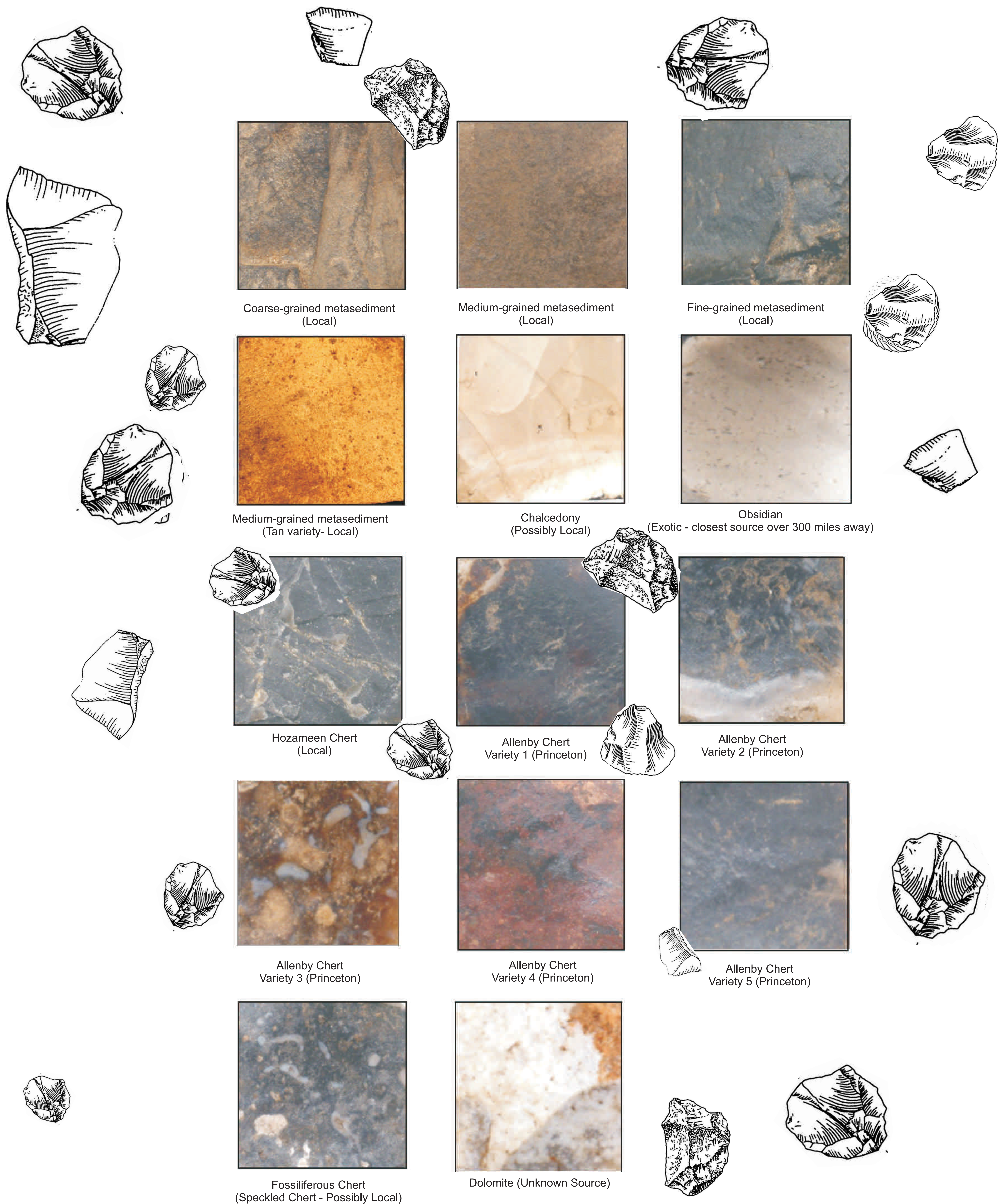


# LITHIC (STONE) RAW MATERIALS



Waste flakes from the production and maintenance of stone tools provide researchers with insight to the movement of people and trade materials. These raw materials were identified at Site DgRf-1 (Mowich Camp) in Manning Provincial Park during a survey of the Skyline Trail by Stó:lō Nation Archaeologists. The variety suggests that the users of the site had a great knowledge of local materials, traveled far to access the area, and/or had established trade agreements with people throughout the Northwest.
